English Language Proficiency

Instructions to ELP Applicants

Assessing English Language Proficiency (ELP) to meet the requirements for flight crew licensing requires an assessment test which can be carried through CAA-approved ELP Assessor which assess language proficiency by means of a formal assessment test. (for Level 4 – 6)

An ELP endorsement at Level 6 has no periodic re-evaluation requirement. At Level 5 (Extended Level) a re-evaluation is required every six years and at Level 4 (Operational Level) every three years.

Your ELP will need to be reassessed depending on the assessment results:

- a) Level 4: every 3 years
- b) Level 5: every 6 years
- c) Level 6: no expiry.

You must be reassessed before the end of this period to continue to exercise the privileges of your licence.

Requirements to hold an ELP:

You will need to hold a current Aviation English Language Proficiency to get your:

- a) Flight crew Licence (FCL)
- b) Air Traffic Controller Licence (ATCL)

Assessment Criteria:

Assessment will take 20 to 30 minutes. You will be assessed on:

- a) Pronunciation
- b) Structure
- c) Vocabulary
- d) Fluency
- e) Comprehension
- f) Interactions.

You will be scored between 1 and 6. The overall rating will be the lowest of these scores.
